## Principal's Message

Book Week is next week and there is great excitement building in anticipation of the activities that are planned.

Book Week is run by the Children's Book Council, it celebrates outstanding books for children and highlights the importance of reading. It is actually the longest running children's festival in Australia and celebrates its 68<sup>th</sup> birthday in 2013. Not quite as old as Kingsville Primary School but certainly a long standing tradition in schools and libraries across our state. This year the theme is

***"read across the universe"***

and that is something our students will all be engaging in throughout the week.

To finish the week on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> there will be a **"book character parade"**. Students should come to school in their dress ups and they will parade straight after the P-2 or 3-6 assembly. Parents please note, instead of the usual whole school Friday get together there will be just for this one Friday, a junior and senior school assembly.

 (children then will move outside to parade around in front of the stage area)

**Year 3-6 assembly** 9.35a.m. – 10.15a.m.  
 (this will include the item by 5/6D current teacher Rhonda McCleod and then, again outside to parade around)

We are dividing the assembly times up in this way as 550 students in uniform is a squeeze, but 550 in costumes could be *"a bridge too far"*.
