Permission sought note – further information

This was a 2 page communication sent home for each Kingsville student back on August 20th. The covering letter was headed **PERMISSION SOUGHT**, the permission sought was for ***the taking and using photographs, electronic recording and/or publishing of your child's/children's images or their work by DEECD (Department of Education and Early Childhood Development) and Kingsville Primary.***

Thank you to the many parents who have returned the form over the last 2 weeks. We are still however waiting on around 20% of these to come back. I know there have been some questions to teachers regarding the context of the request - *permission sought* therefore, some further clarification is provided below.

- this permission is sought in the first instance by Department of Education and Early Childhood Development (DEECD)
- this is because Kingsville Primary School is a Victorian Government school and as part of that system, it would be limiting and not accurate if the Kingsville Primary School i.e. our leadership and governance only asked for permission
- unfortunately in a number of schools where parents only gave their permission to the school, there have been issues when DEECD was given material by a school to use in e.g. a publication or education site
- KPS leadership and staff will control what is on our website and other publications and at times we may volunteer or, provide as requested (and we see this as an honour) material for other government projects or associated educational purposes
e.g. **FUSE** (Find, Use and Share Education), is an Education Department portal that aims to host and deliver a wide range of teaching and learning content. Links from this to State Library, Museum Victoria and Science Works are common and articles from students are often included
- please note any use of photos, recording or work can only be within the parameters set out in the information sent to you

We wish to be able to use group photos often at KPS and constant checking or moving children out of some activity when filming/recording is difficult for teachers.

Having said this we understand that there may be a small number of parents/guardians who do not wish to give their permission.

If this is the case we require parents to evidence their intent by writing on the form.

I DO NOT GIVE SUCH CONSENT AS REQUESTED (and sign and date). Just sending back an unsigned form will not clearly demonstrate intent.

Therefore if you have sent an unsigned form back to class teachers, it will come back to you. Please then clearly state your intent and return the form.
