Celebrating and acknowledging a brilliant career

On March 31st this year Sheri Seyit will spend her last day in the classroom. Sheri is taking some long service leave at the beginning of term 2 and will be resigning from DET Victoria on June 1st. This will be a significant day for Sheri or, Mrs Seyit as she is known by many and, none less so for the KPS school community.

In noting school community, I am of course including the thousands of families and students whose lives Mrs Seyit has touched since her first day here on 1st June 1978 as a teaching assistant. Thirty nine years working in education for the Government of Victoria, thirty seven of those as a teacher at Kingsville – 1/6/1978 to 1/6/2017 just amazing.

Whilst we have had at Kingsville a number of staff who have stayed for long periods of time Mrs Seyit has dedicated her entire career to the students of KPS. She has taught every class area from Foundation to year 6 and a number of specialist areas including Library, Reading Recovery and Visual Arts. An extraordinary achievement and, one which will ensure a legacy which will impact on future generations of Kingsville students for many years to come.

Such a milestone of course will be acknowledged and celebrated by staff, students and the school council over the next three weeks. At the final assembly of the term on March 31st, Mrs Seyit will be farewelled with appropriate 'pomp'. Parents are always welcome to attend assemblies however, as you may be aware space in the hall for parent seating is limited. Therefore, parents you may wish to take up the opportunity to send Sheri a farewell email or, drop a note/message in for her. I know from experience it is those short messages, notes or card teachers always appreciate and treasure.

From my perspective as Principal I would like to take this opportunity to publicly thank Sheri for her long and valuable contribution to this school. I along with staff, students and parents will miss her greatly but, of course we all wish her well in the next exciting stage of her life.
