# Italian News

## **Cooking 'Pollo alla parmigiana' Chicken parmigiana in Italian Class**

Last Thursday during Italian class all the 5 and 6 children made some yummy 'Pollo alla parmigiana' (Chicken Parma)!

*"I really enjoyed cooking the Pollo alla parmigiana. It was really fun. We chopped up the tomatoes and garlic and made them into a sauce. Then we got out the chicken and covered it in sauce and mozzarella cheese. I liked it because we saw how to cook Italian food and learnt how to make sauce."* Hadlee Koop

### **How to Make the Pollo alla parmigiana we made at school:**

Ingredients for the sauce:

- 2 tablespoons olive oil (olio)
- 2 cloves garlic (aglio)
- 1 onion (cipolla)
- 1 kg tomatoes (pomodori)
- Handful of herbs (erbe aromatiche)
- Salt and pepper (sale e pepe)

How to make it:

- Chop onions or crush onions and fry in olive oil until softened.
- Add in chopped tomatoes and herbs and cook for 45 minutes.
- \*If you like chunky sauce serve as it is,
- \*If you like smooth process with food processor or stick blender.
- \*Depending on your taste, add bacon, salami, capsicum, mushrooms, olives for pasta sauce.

We then added this to our pre-crumbed chicken with mozzarella cheese on top and cooked in the oven for 30 minutes.
