Australian Mathematics Competition

A big congratulations to the 77 students from grades 3 – 6 who participated in the annual Australian Mathematics Competition on Thursday 28th of August. The Australian Mathematics Competition has been held annually since 1978. This is Kingsville Primary Schools 3rd year of involvement and the number of participants has grown each year. There is an emphasis on problem solving; a valuable life skill, and the questions are designed to be fun for the student.

Over 1,000 students share the prizes on offer for competing and around 50% of participants qualify to receive a Certificate of High Distinction, Distinction or Credit. All other entrants in the competition receive a Certificate of Participation or a Proficiency Certificate. All students are also provided with a detailed report showing how they performed on each problem with wider statistical rankings.

A prestigious Australian Mathematics Competition medal is awarded to students with an outstanding result, both within a region and overall in the competition.

Student test have now been sent to Canberra for marking and results will be announced later in the year.

Here is an example of the type of question that the students had to answer

Five towns are joined by a system of roads as shown.

How many different ways are there of travelling from town *P* to town *T* if, on any particular journey, no road is used more than once and no town is passed more than once?

(A) 4 (B) 5 (C) 6 (D) 7 (E) 8

In the year 5 classroom, the desks are arranged in equal rows. Phil sits at the desk that is fourth from the front and third from the back. There are four desks on the right of Phil's desk but only one to the left. How many desks are there in the room?

Tickets go on sale on Monday 1st August

This year our production features over 80 students in Years 5 and 6. It is a magical and hilarious fairy-tale themed show with many well-known characters and a rocking musical score. Students have been working hard for the past four months and are looking forward to putting on three fantastic performances for the school community on the **16th, 17th and 18th of August**. For these three nights, the school hall will be magically transformed into a theatre with professional-quality lighting and sound. Similar to last year's performance, you have the option of purchasing reserved seats but this year we are also adding a **floor section for children (see below for details)**.

Floor section for children - (This is a child section only and no adults will be permitted to sit in this area)

- If you would like your **child to be seated with you this is NOT the option for you**. You will need to purchase a reserved seat for them, as we cannot provide seating near the floor section for all parents.
- The floor section for children will be located at the front near the stage ideal for smaller children. There will be gym mats for them to sit on so they will not have an obstructed view of the performance. **For safety reasons – NO pillows or cushions will be allowed in this area.**
- If you are interested in purchasing a spot on the floor for your child, please note:
 - There are a **limited number** of spots available on the floor for each performance - these must be purchased through trybooking (they are available at half price of a reserved seat).
 - Children **need to be responsible** enough to **sit on their own, away from you**, and remain seated throughout the performance.
 - There will be a couple of volunteers seated at the front to help supervise the floor section, but your ***child remains your responsibility.***
