Principal's Message

Planning for the 2016 school year

Planning for 2016 now begins in earnest and, the actual number of students enrolled at Kingsville is the key component in planning for all provision. From the number of grades, staff able to be provided, rooms that can be used, right down to furniture and even the cleaning budget all arise from that “magic number”.

School staffing is a very complex area and ensuring we have just the right number of teaching and support staff and are able to adhere to all relevant industrial agreements is never easy.

Kingsville parents/guardians you can assist greatly with this by

1. giving us notice **now** if your child/children will be leaving Kingsville Primary School at the end of 2015 or in early 2016
2. making sure that if you have a child to enrol in Preps for 2016 that you have completed the full enrolment process - there should not be for example, any sibling prep enrolments for 2016 coming in at this stage of the year unless special circumstances are involved
3. spreading the word to any friends/neighbours that you know of who may live in the **“school neighbourhood area”** and have not yet made contact to enrol their child

The **“Transition to Prep Program”** is coming up on November 6th, 12th and 21st and it is very important for as many as possible of our 2016 Prep cohort are involved in this experience.

Student Placement for 2016

At this early stage in Term 4 it is important for all parents to be aware of our "class placement" process.

Please note

As students at Kingsville progress from prep to year 6 it is expected they will learn to work and relate to a range of teachers and students. As with all school decisions, the aim at Kingsville Primary School is to offer the best possible learning experience for all children. When we are compiling class lists many factors are taken into account including academic abilities, individual needs, gender, student friendships and previous class placements/teachers. We also look at what is in the best educational interests of all students.

It is important to note that class groups are not allocated a teacher until the whole school class model is completed. This ensures that it is the 'dynamic' of each group that is the focus rather than, a particular teacher.

Class groups will be ready for our 'Step Up Program' in early December. This experience will provide students an opportunity to meet both their new class mates and their teacher for 2016. Of course this is dependent on all our teaching positions being filled by that time which is not always the case. At this stage who all of the teaching staff will be in 2016 is an unknown. We have like all schools, a number of teachers on short term contracts and, longer term contracts linked to permanent Kingsville staff currently on Parental Absence Leave. A number of these staff will be returning in 2016 in both a full time and part time capacity plus, current staff may apply for and gain positions elsewhere.

Parents are asked to assist the process by not requesting a particular teacher or placement for a child. If there are specific educational considerations that a parent believes need to be considered of course we would want to know about these. Unless they are new however we would expect to already be aware of such matters.

There will be more information about class groups and school organisation as the term progresses.

The Primary Years Programme (PYP) exhibition is a requirement of all authorized PYP schools. It represents a significant event in the life of a PYP student, making sense of the essential elements, skills, knowledge, attitudes, concepts and action of the PYP and sharing them with the whole school community.

The exhibition provides the culminating experience of the student's engagement with the Primary Years Programme (PYP) and provides a forum for demonstrating the attributes of the Learner Profile to our community.

The staging of the exhibition in week three of this term is the culmination of this extended collaborative investigation and our students are looking forward to sharing their learning with both their parents and the wider school community. The transdisciplinary theme being explored is **HOW THE WORLD WORKS** - *an inquiry into the natural world and its laws; the interaction between the natural world (physical and biological) and human societies; how humans use their understanding of scientific principles; the impact of scientific and technological advances on society and on the environment.*

I encourage all parents, including those from other year levels, to take this opportunity to visit our exhibition and talk with our fantastic grade 6 students. To experience the exhibition begin in the grade 5/6 building and then make your way to the hall. The exhibition is open on:
