### **Booking Method**

1. login to the Trybooking site <http://www.trybooking.com/html/buyTickets.shtml>.
2. search "Kingsville" or "Adventure". The link to the show will appear.
3. select 'Continue Booking'
4. select the night you wish to attend.
5. select/highlight the seat locations you want. Note: If you are booking for a second or third night click on the link 'This Event' and process through again
6. click 'checkout' and complete the payment process.

Parents who have any computer access problems at home may use the computer in the foyer of the school.

### **Australian Maths Competition**

Results have now become available for the 38<sup>th</sup> annual Australian Mathematics Competition (AMC) sponsored by the Commonwealth Bank. Hundreds of students in primary and secondary schools from around 30 countries sat the AMC on 30<sup>th</sup> July.

Kingsville entered 32 students this year, up from 15 in 2014. 6 students received Distinctions, 16 Credits and 9 Proficiency certificates. All students who competed received a Certificate of Participation and every entrant is provided with an individual performance report.

Congratulations to all the students who participated, our results clearly show we have many students with a passion and commitment for mathematics.

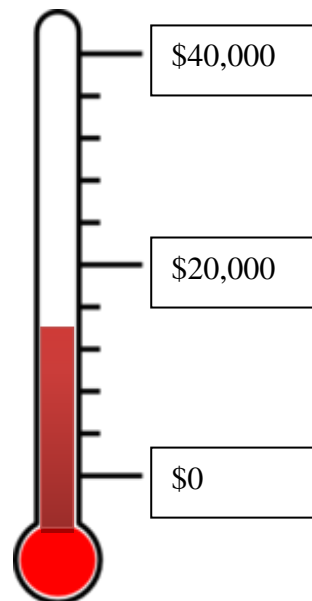
## Parent Payment

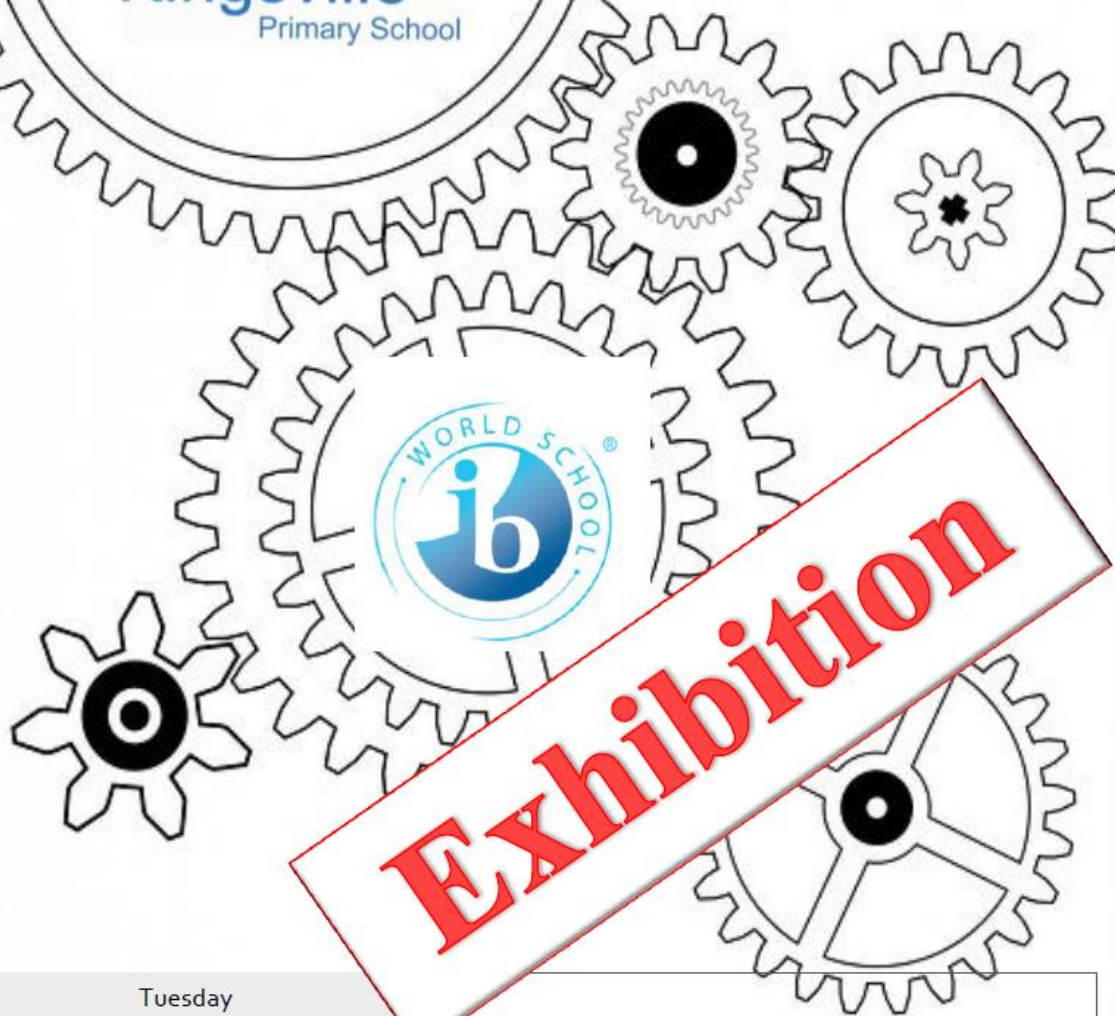
