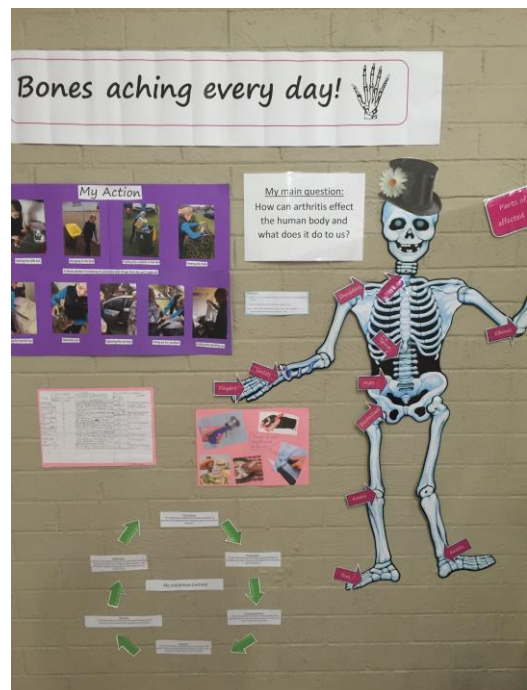
It was a great experience for all children involved, and I am pleased to let you know that we now have some children going to Albert Park next Monday for the State Athletics Championships!!

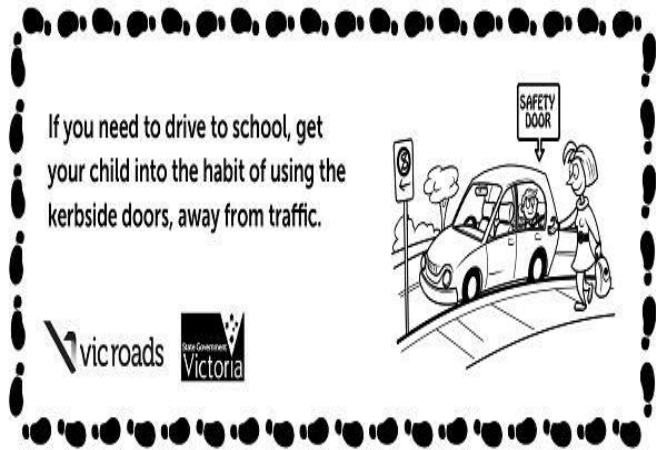
