## Principal's Message

Receiving a Kingsville student award or participating in a class item at Friday morning assembly is always a memorable occasion for students. Parents are often able to attend and it can be standing room only and cameras/devices “at the ready”, when the Prep students perform.

It is of course acknowledged that it is not always possible for a parent or parents to be able to be in the audience for every award or performance over the seven years of primary school. This is just the reality of life and children need to be made aware of this.

What is very important however, is that all families have knowledge of the assembly item roster and when their child/children are going to receive a student award. This ensures the occasion and/or achievement is able to be acknowledged in the first instance at home with family. If parents are able to be in the audience for some of these occasions then that is a bonus.

To assist families with planning the dates of class assembly items and, details of which students will receive awards are always given in advance.
