Principal's Message

Parent, Caregiver and Guardian Opinion Survey 2022

Previously known as the Parent Opinion Survey the Parent, Caregiver and Guardian Opinion Survey 2022, will again take place across the state this term.

At Kingsville Primary School parent opinion and feedback is highly valued. The use of opinion data on a range of issues and, as a measure of school performance is vital in working to ensure our school is the very best it can be.

We encourage and request parent feedback and opinion throughout the year and also involve parents, teachers and students in the annual anonymous Department of Education and Training state wide opinion surveys.

This Parent Opinion Survey held in Term 3 each year is one that parents may be involved in a number of times over the 13 years of primary and secondary education for their child/children. Selection for inclusion in this survey is by a random sample involving 30% of parents.

We encourage all parents selected for 2022 to complete the survey as soon as possible within the time period provided. The opinions and data gained will be used in yearly school review processes and, will contribute towards whole school planning for improvement.

Q: How will I know if I am included in the 2022 survey?

A: Parents who have been selected to participate through the random sample selection process will receive an email with log in details and, guidance information.

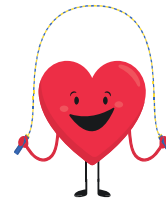
Father's Day Stall

Respectful Relationships Update

Kingsville Primary School has continued to incorporate the Respectful Relationships (RR) program within the teaching and learning at KPS. The RR program along with the **Resilience, Rights and Respectful Relationships (RRRR)** curriculum, provides an avenue to explicitly teach our children how to build healthy relationships, engage in respectful and thoughtful encounters, and develop resilience and confidence. Here are some photos of activities the students completed, that explored the following themes:

- Help seeking options
- Role-play activities (peer-help)
- Positive coping strategies (strategies to calm down)
- Movement breaks eg. Dance/move how you feel.
- 'Feelings pockets' that describes emotions
