Principal's Message

Term 3, 2022 concludes next Friday September 16th and together we have made our way through a 10 week term which began back on Monday July 11th. It has been a term which has seen provision for a wide range of experiences and in turn, resulting high levels of student engagement. We have also seen the increased return of parents and community members to the school site.

It has however also been a challenging term marked by high levels of staff and student absence and schools across the state have had to address this current system wide issue. Here at Kingsville I am pleased to say we managed to ensure full coverage and provision for students with replacement teachers.

We look forward now to term 4 when hopefully levels of attendance increase and, levels of illness decrease throughout our whole school community. As was the case throughout the entire period of 2020 – 2021, the resilience and tenacity displayed by parents / carers extended family members, students, and staff could accurately be aligned again this year to what we term the "Bulldog Spirit".

Term 4 begins on Monday October 3rd with thankfully no phased transition to online learning this year as was the case at the beginning of term 4 2021. The final term of 2022 is expected to be one of continued re-engagement with the school community and working to ensure more of the expected and usual term 4 events take place onsite. Transition, Step Up, Graduation and all that goes with planning for the new school year is of course part of the program and term 4 experience.

Foundation
