We would like to remind families that if you need to alter your booking it is very important that you contact the head office. They will change your booking to fit your circumstances, the number is 1300 105 343. It is also important that you also phone the service number on 0401 054 261 to identify us if any changes are being made especially if there is a late booking. Also to add if you have collected the child early from school knowing your child is booked for after care PLEASE let us know on 0401 054 261. Please let your children remind the children on the day to come to after care room if booked, when school is finished.

Reminder for the new children especially for Foundation students, our policy and training states that children in Foundation classrooms only will be collected from classroom and taken to after care room with the educator.

Reminder for families who have children with medication to please come a day prior to your booking to complete an action plan with the medication labelled. This will be effective as it will prepare us for any additional training for your child.
