Principal's Message

Education Week in the Victorian Government education sector is always an opportunity to profile and acknowledge the strengths and achievements of schools and students across the state. This year Education Week which began back in 1944, will take place during the week of 22nd – 28th May. Every year there is a theme announced for the week and in 2022 it is “**150 Years of Public Education**”.

Our school Kingsville Primary School is a historic Victorian Government school which first opened the doors on August 1st, 1919. It has strong generational ties and is proud of 103 years of providing an educational setting for children in the Yarraville /Kingsville area and beyond.

The official school number 3988, which you can see up high in the plaster work on the side of the building facing Somerville Road indicates where the school sits in the history of government school buildings. School official numbers link to the dates of opening as listed in official government records.

Kingsville was built by Frank Schillabeer one time major of Footscray, who was also a keen campaigner for education opportunities for the Western suburbs of Melbourne.

Education Week 2022 is certainly an opportunity for all KPS students and families to commemorate the past, celebrate the present and imagine the future of education in Victoria.

Whilst 103 years is impressive **congratulations** to Bacchus Marsh Primary School the oldest Victorian Government school still open. The school officially opened on May 13th 1850 today therefore, is their 172nd birthday.

ONLINE ORDERING Your child's school photos are now available for secure online purchase, please note if you are ordering online, you do not need to return an envelope to the school

4 EASY STEPS TO ONLINE SCHOOL PHOTO ORDERING

Step 1: Click Here - For online ordering process for your school.

- OR - Go to www.advancedlife.com.au before photo day and enter your school code [ZXB YJ7 YLX]

Step 2: Enter your student's details

Step 3: Choose the package that best suits your needs (all orders will be returned to the school for collection)

Step 4: Pay for the photos via the shopping cart (upper right corner of the page)

****Online Orders have a 1.5% merchant fee applied when using Visa, Mastercard or PayPal.**

Please Note: If you miss photo day, portrait and group packages can still be ordered online for 7 days afterwards with no late fees. After that time, late orders will require separate processing and handling and therefore will incur a \$15 late fee per package.
